

School Growth

Enrolment at Bringelly has reached a point in the past year that the school has been reclassified as a PP4 level school which means an adjustment in staffing for 2015. This change from a PP5 school means that my position as Principal is now a non-teaching role and the school will have an executive team of two assistant principals. The new position of Assistant Principal will be advertised this term.

We have a lovely group of children who are in the Coming to Big School Program every Friday. The program is for 4 weeks and while parents are being spoken to about learning at school, learning to read, healthy lunch boxes and a speech pathologist, the new kindy's have met their big school buddies and had an activity time planned by a trained pre-school teacher. The P&C have also spoken to the new parents (although many parents have children already attending Bringelly) and the new uniforms have already been bought for next year.

We also welcomed JEHS new Principal Mr Weatherstone, to meet the 2015 students and with me to discuss links between the high school and Bringelly with enrichment days and exchange days.
