Excursion Notes

If there is any difficulty with payments the office will be able to arrange deferment if contact has been made ahead of time to make another arrangement. It is better to make a tentative arrangement rather than leave it too late for your child to enjoy an excursion.

Bush Fire Danger

The following alert has been sent to the school and it is a timely reminder that this summer will be hot and unfortunately also with a high fire hazard. At the school we will practice our fire safety drill for bushfire at the beginning of the year and we have already completed our normal fire drill. We are grateful to the very close link we have with the Bringelly RFS.

A Severe Fire Danger Rating and total fire ban will be issued throughout summer for the following fire weather areas:

Schools within these areas are asked to stay well informed of any fire activity by monitoring local media and regularly checking for updates on the NSW RFS website or NSW RFS information line on 1800 679 737. Fires can threaten suddenly and without warning, take notice of any warnings issued seriously and be prepared to act.
