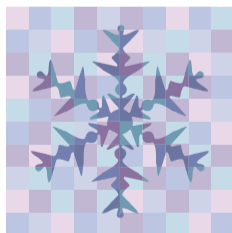

What another busy week for Bringelly!

All classes have started their dance lessons with Dance Lab on Tuesdays.
