Dear Parents/Carers,

At Bringelly Public School we promote student safety at all times. Now that our Kindergarten students have had the opportunity to settle in to the school environment, we will be keeping our gates closed until **2:55pm**. This is to allow our students and staff the space to conduct lessons in outdoor spaces at the end of the day free of traffic. Our school leaders will be responsible for opening the gates at 2:55pm each day and parents/carers will be able to enter the school at this time.

We are also encouraging a drop and go prior to the bell by parents in the mornings to allow the students to play and be supervised by teachers and SLSO's. This encourages our students to play independently and learn new skills. We thank you for your cooperation with this as we encourage independence.

All messages and information will be provided at school assemblies and/or through School Bytes. This will keep the morning student line up brief and students can enter classrooms quickly to begin learning.
